

Terms and Conditions

The Food Library Summer Solstice Residential Event at Hideaway Wood Farm June 20th-22nd 2025

Event Overview:

This is a small residential event hosted by The Food Library at Hideaway Wood Farm, Dodford, Northamptonshire. The event includes camping pitch, glamping or camper van pitch, all meals, and workshops on foraging and fermenting, led by guest facilitators. Full details are outlined on The Food Library website.

1. Attendance & Supervision:

- 1.1 All attendees must purchase a ticket in advance.
- 1.2 Children under 18 are welcome but must be accompanied and supervised at all times by a paying adult.
- 1.3 Workshops are designed for adults and may not be suitable for children. Supervising adults are fully responsible for their children's safety and participation.
- 1.4 Meals for children will be provided.
- 1.5 Damages must be paid for.
- 1.6 Arrival for weekend camping is to be no earlier than 4pm on Friday 20th June.
- 1.7 Departure for weekend camping is to be no later than 11am on Sunday 22nd June.
- 1.8 Arrival for 1-day ticket on Saturday June 21st is to be between 10am and 10:30am to allow for parking and welcomes.
- 1.9 Departure for 1-day ticket on Saturday June 21st is to be no later than 11pm. Attendees are asked to depart quietly.
- 1.10 We want all guests to feel welcome and secure. All team members and guests are to be treated with respect.

2. Workshops & Activities:

- 2.1 The event will proceed in all weather conditions. Activities may be adjusted in response to weather.
- 2.2 A recommended kit list for campers will be provided to help attendees prepare

appropriately.

- 2.3 The workshops are led by guest experts Rob Gould, Alex McAllister Lunt and Lizzy Farmer.
- 2.4 The site is run by Hideaway Wood Farm. Please note that there are Alpacas on site. These animals are to be given a wide berth.
- 2.5 Dogs and other pets are unable to attend this event.
- 2.6 No glass is to be bought to site.
- 2.7 Glamping and all facilities are provided by Hideaway Wood Farm.

3. Meals & Allergies:

- 3.1 All meals are included in the ticket price.
- 3.2 The Food Library maintains a 5-star food hygiene rating.
- 3.3 Attendees must notify The Food Library of any dietary requirements or allergies at the time of booking.
- 3.4 Attendees are responsible for bringing any necessary medication, including for allergies.

4. Refunds & Transfers:

- 4.1 Due to the level of preparation required, all tickets are **non-refundable**.
- 4.2 Tickets may, however, be **transferred to another attendee** with prior notice to The Food Library via michael@food-library.co.uk.

5. Health & Safety:

- 5.2 Attendees participate in all activities at their own risk and are responsible for their personal safety and belongings.
